Shipping Parcels to Jersey

Customs require us to provide additional information for them to calculate the Goods and Services Tax, which is **a legal requirement on the island**.

To allow us to ship your parcels to Jersey, it is necessary for you to complete a **Channel Islands invoice and attach it to each parcel that you send**.

To enable the speedy processing of Customs paperwork, **you must declare who you are sending the goods to, a full description of the item and its value**.



Without a Channel Islands invoice we will have no choice but to return your parcel. **Please help us to process your parcels without delay by providing the above.**
